PAC 2019 Theme:

For the glory of God, Becoming True Disciple, Growing True Church, Doing True Mission!

1 (Mon) Uni Students (S Cn)

A new committee is formed to lead the Uni Student group, may God use them and give them the spiritual strength and wisdom to lead the cell groups. Pray God may lead the mentors in how to cultivate the new leaders for the student/youth ministry.

2 (Tue) OT Survey (CLEI)

The Old Testament Overview course has been running since 6th of March; in total there are 10 classes with 54 members. Pray for the spiritual and physical wellbeing of the members; may this course renew their lives, experience and love of God.

3 (Wed) North Youth (theBridge) We thank our Heavenly Father for the work that He is doing in the hearts of the youth, as they hear and respond to the gospel. Please pray for the UF leaders to be able to present Christ clearly in His Word, and pray for His Spirit to move the hearts of the youth to love Jesus more deeply.

4 (Thu) Family Camp (NMn)

18 (Thu) Recovery (S Mn)
