North Cantonese + English (Prepared by Joy Auyeung)

1. North Cantonese Ministry Committee retreat finished well by His grace and your prayers. We had open and honest sharing. At the end we affirmed our commitment to one another and to the church. We have agreed on two core values for our Congregation:

Fervent prayer -- listen to the Holy Spirit Relationship building -- serve in unity

We commit ourselves to attend prayer meetings regularly. We encourage each other to bring out the best in others for ministry.

- 2. Church Planting Launch Team:
 - May the Holy Spirit anoint and cover the Team with power to be witnesses of the Gospel. A young mother from Muslim heritage and her 3.5 years old son have been attending PACN a few times. Rina Fu has been regularly reading the Bible with her and another new Christian from Sudan. Pray for fruit bearing with all the work that God has been leading us to do.
 - The Bridge Launch Team is praying and planning for a few outreach activities targeted at families in the community (for example Fun Day, Parenting Seminars, Kids Club). May the Lord guide us in the best ways to love and care for the people whom He brings. We trust that He will prepare the resources and provide faithful labourers to win people for Jesus.
- 3. UF- United Fellowship: Please pray for the UF mentoring strategy, that more regular meetings can be established. Please pray for the two mentoring groups (total of 6 older youths) meeting fortnightly. Pray that these groups will be effective in discipling the youth to deepen their love for Jesus through Scripture and deepening relationships with each other.
- 4. The Caleb cell group was created this year for mature-age adults. This platform allows them to share their life experiences together and receive

- 2. South Cantonese congregation will be holding a Belmont Fun Day on 12th October 2019, to interact and serve the Belmont community. The organising committee are already preparing for the Day, with help from Mandarin congregation and PACE. Ask the Lord to help us to have a clear communication and great teamwork. Also ask the Lord to motivate more people to participate.
- 3. Ask the Lord to strengthen Pastor Kevin and his co-workers in the Cantonese ministry committee: Monica, Danny, Lena, Phyllis, Mavis, Allison, Philip, Catherine, so that they will be blessed by the Lord in work, family, life and health. Pray for a strong spirituality, to lead brother and sister to serve the Lord
