5/12 5/1	The Combined English Youth Group will have their final meeting for this year on Friday 7th December. Pray that as they study the Scriptures they would develop a love for God's word and grow in their faith in Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. ° <span style="color: red;">(S. Eng. Youth Group)</span>
6/12 6/1	Pray for the short term mission trip to South Thailand in January organized by our church and CCMN-HK. It will be led by Pastor Rolf and there will be a total of 9 people in the team. From 14 <sup>th</sup> to 17 <sup>th</sup> January, there will be a training at the Wu Kwai Sha Youth Village in HK. From 18 <sup>th</sup> to 26 <sup>th</sup> they will engage in volunteer work in South Thailand.
